



### Community Living Groups Benefit from CCCU Mortgage Promotion

**Campbell River – May 24, 2006:** This spring, Community Living groups throughout Vancouver Island will benefit from Coastal Community Credit Union's (CCCU) mortgage promotion. Until almost 1960, people with developmental disabilities were routinely sent to live in institutions. Up to that time, it was believed that handicapped people were better off in a segregated living environment, both for their own protection and that of their community. That mindset began to change in the 1960s as parents, caregivers and communities began to advocate ways to integrate these individuals into the community. Community Living is about helping people with special needs live full, enriching lives.

Greg Hill from the Campbell River and District Association for Community Living (CRADACL) explains, "The CRADACL provides a centre where people with special needs can socialize together in an atmosphere of respect and understanding. The Association's employees provide physical, speech and pathological therapy to clients, and supervise day programs to teach life, work, and self-advocacy skills."
