Coastal Community Credit Union Announces Recipients of 2009 Coastal Spirit Fund

VANCOUVER ISLAND, BC CANADA - Fifty one non-profit organizations are a little richer thanks to Coastal Community Credit Union—and that means they'll be able to help more Vancouver Islanders in need. They are the recipients of the Credit Union's 2009 Coastal Spirit Fund, through which \$144,900 is being awarded to fund worthwhile community initiatives across Vancouver Island.

Over 170 community groups applied to the 2009 Coastal Spirit Fund, representing \$1.7 Million in requests. "There is considerable need in our communities," says Joe Cristiano, Coastal Community's Senior Vice President of Marketing. "The Coastal Spirit Fund helps us to meet the unique needs of Vancouver Island communities. We have Community Connection Councils in each region to help direct funding to make a tangible difference in the communities we serve."

Coastal Community formed the Coastal Spirit Fund in 2006 to meet the diverse needs of Vancouver Island communities. In the three years since the program's inception, more than \$450,000 has been awarded to help fund over 150 community initiatives. With the help of the Credit Union's volunteer Councils, funding decisions are made locally and funds are distributed regionally in the areas of the Environment, Health, Community Service, Youth & Education, Sports & Recreation, and Arts & Culture.

In addition to the funds awarded through the Coastal Spirit Fund, Coastal Community provided over \$200,000 in 2008 to Vancouver Island communities through a variety of initiatives. "Our community investment programs help support the well-being of the communities where we do business," adds Cristiano, "and when our communities thrive, so do we."
