Coastal Community Credit Union RRSP Campaign helps fund hospital beds

Campbell River, February 7, 2006. Every RRSP deposit made at Coastal Community Credit Union (CCCU) on or before March 1 will help buy a new intensive-care bed at the Campbell River Hospital.

"We will donate \$5 to the Campbell River Hospital Foundation for each RRSP deposit we receive," says Francois Egan, manager of CCCU's Willow Point and Discovery Harbour branches. "When members invest in their retirement, they are also supporting our hospital."

"The CCCU funds will go towards the cost of buying intensive care beds," says Diana Williamson, Executive Director of the Campbell River Hospital Foundation. "Each bed costs \$25,000, so every little bit helps. We are thrilled that CCCU has decided to help us again this year. Last year they raised just over \$1,600 for us, and over the past few years their contributions have totaled almost \$13,000."

"Each year we choose a community partner to share in the success of our RRSP campaign," says Egan. "We seek partners who share our vision to be leaders in our communities and those who help to improve the lives of others."

RRSP contributions for the 2005 tax year can be made with Coastal Community Credit Union on or before March 1, 2005.
