Jim has over 30 years of business experience, in roles ranging from technician to Vice President. His breadth of experience includes operations, HR, marketing, IT, finance and project management. Over his lengthy career, Jim has helped launch three startup companies (Terago Networks, CallGenie, and Metronet), and provided management expertise for long-established organizations such as Bell Canada and AT&T. He has managed teams as large as 250, ran projects spanning multiple years (Metronet Launch) with budgets of \$25M or more, as well as overseen the building of data centres and operations departments from the ground up for both Terago Networks and CallGenie.

As Mayor of Clinton from 2011 to 2018, Jim successfully attained \$4M in grants to build a new water treatment plant for Clinton, a new water main system and several new hiking trails boasting tourism in the area, thru lobbying provisional and federal governments. As Mayor, Jim ushered in the Clinton Community Forest which has brought \$777,263 to the village and \$501,686 to non-profit local organizations, as of 2024.

Jim is a strong believer in the value that credit unions bring to communities. He was elected as a Director of Integris Credit Union in 2019 and participated on all Board committees over the six years leading up to the merger with Coastal Community Credit Union. He served as Chair of the Integris Board for three years.
